Summary of Experience

Dan is a Senior Associate with over a decade of international experience, having worked across Europe, South America, Australia and Asia on projects ranging from large-scale infrastructure and mixed-use projects to high-end hospitality, residential towers and workplace design.

Dan has contributed to several significant global projects, including major transport and aviation schemes such as Metro Tunnel Project in Melbourne, Mexico City Airport and European transport masterplans, alongside civic and sports-led developments in South America. He played a design role on the Atrio office towers in Bogotá and the National Stadium of Venezuela in Caracas, gaining experience in large-scale urban and public architecture.

In the UK, Dan has worked extensively on complex projects through detailed and construction stages. This includes a leading role in the fit-out of RSHP's studio on Level 14 of the Leadenhall Building, where the practice's design philosophy was reinterpreted as a flexible, legible and collaborative workplace within a fully open floorplate.

He has also worked on the detail and construction stages of the refurbishment and redesign of The Berkeley hotel and its facilities; the extension of the hotel's north block and the insertion of a new hotel - The Emory - into the Berkeley site.

Dan's UK experience also includes mixed-use and residential-led developments, such as a large-scale student accommodation scheme in west London and the MK Gateway scheme in Milton Keynes, comprising residential, commercial and community buildings set around a new civic public realm.

Currently, Dan is project architect for two high-rise residential towers in Taiwan, building on his broader experience in Asia. Alongside project work, he has contributed to product design and research initiatives, including furniture systems and bespoke architectural components developed in collaboration with industry partners.
