Summary of Experience

María is a Senior Associate with over fifteen years' experience delivering large-scale mixed-use, transport and infrastructure, and residential projects. She was a key member of the team responsible for the design of the public realm and podium buildings for ATRIO, a major mixed-use commercial development in central Bogotá, Colombia, comprising two towers set above a large open public space at ground level.

She also contributed to the competition for Mexico City International Airport and to the schematic design stages of the FIFA National Football Stadium in Caracas, Venezuela, alongside a wider masterplan introducing a new metropolitan park and integrating two stadia with a transport hub.

In 2016 María was a lead team member on the detailed design of the interior fit-out for a new terminal at Taoyuan International Airport in Taipei, Taiwan. She relocated to Taipei for eight months to collaborate with local teams and ensure the design intent and quality were delivered. Prior to this, she played a key role in the airport planning team coordinating with engineers, the client and stakeholders.

From 2017 - 2023, María worked on the Hammersmith & Fulham Civic Campus, contributing to the refurbishment and extension of the town hall, the coordination of three residential buildings, and later overseeing construction progress on site.

She later led the team on MK Gateway in Milton Keynes, delivering a 32-storey residential tower with two podium levels and 288 units and was subsequently Design Guardian role for both the residential tower and office building.

In 2025, she worked on Stages 3 and 4 of the T4 Barajas Expansion with Estudio Lamela in Madrid and then worked on the competition and design development of a new terminal at Casablanca Airport. María is currently working on a transport and infrastructure project in London and is also a member of RSHP's Recruitment Team, supporting talent development and promoting an inclusive design culture.
