Summary of Experience

With a broad experience of projects on all stages across Europe, Asia and Australia, Michael has excellent technical design and team leadership skills. From 2015 to its completion in 2021, Michael worked on the extension to Geneva Airport in Switzerland. He was based in Geneva during the construction phase and led the project teams working on the facades, transportation and interiors packages.

Between 2014 and 2015, he worked on the Atrio project in Bogotá comprising two towers – North 42 floors (201 m) and South 58 floors (268 m). Michael led the development of a parametric 3D model to resolve structure and facade coordination in earthquake conditions.

Since 2021, Michael has been project architect for Hotel and Student Accommodation projects at 181 Talgarth Road London.

Between 2023 and 2024, Michael has worked on the Parcs en Scène project, a mixed-use development located near Orly airport in Paris. The project comprises 130,000 m² of mixed-use development, mainly housing and a new digital hub including a 2,500-seat e-sports arena.

Michael is currently the architect for the redevelopment of the Bayeux Tapestry Museum. This project involves restoring and reconfiguring the current museum in a former seminary, and adding a contemporary extension housing a gallery dedicated to the Bayeux Tapestry, a UNESCO-listed historic monument. Prior to working at RSHP, Michael worked on a number of cultural, commercial and residential projects at Johnson Pilton Walker, Sydney. He was project architect for the Australian War Memorial and Art Gallery of New South Wales.

Michael also worked in collaboration with Jørn Utzon Architects on the Sydney Opera House Forecourt and Western Foyers Upgrade, listed by UNESCO as one of the major architectural works of the 20th century.
