Summary of Experience

Trilingual in Italian, French and English, Nicola plays a key role in RSHP's Paris office, providing onsite support for projects in Paris and France. He has a master's degree in urban planning from the LSE, (London School of Economics), which has enabled him to broaden his knowledge of urban planning and sustainable development and to approach architectural issues from other perspectives.

He is currently working on several large-scale projects in the greater Paris area, including a mixed-use, low carbon project at Jean Moulin which will link the central business district of Paris La Défense and the town of Puteaux.

Nicola is also coordinating Les Messageries project which is adjacent to the Gare de Lyon in the Paris 12th arrondissement. Commissioned by Espaces Ferroviaires, (a subsidiary of French national railways SNCF), this masterplan takes its name from this railway site's past activities and will provide a diverse and sustainable neighbourhood structured around a new 3-hectare garden. It will include housing, offices, leisure and recreational activities and the renovation of its historic buildings. It will also set a benchmark in terms of reducing carbon emissions.

Nicola also led the Maine-Montparnasse masterplan for the City of Paris which aimed to radically transform this pivotal neighbourhood of more than 9 hectares, bordering both the Montparnasse station and Tower. The scheme sought to open up the existing buildings on the site, creating new routes and vistas across the previously impassable and introverted shopping centre that currently dominates the approach to the station.

In tandem with his project work, Nicola is also a member of the Sustainability Steering Group, RSHP's sustainable development working group, which collects data, shares experience internally and draws up framework documents to improve the environmental and carbon impact of RSHP's activities.
