## Summary of Experience

Will joined Rogers Stirk Harbour + Partners, (RSHP), in 2013 and became an Associate in 2019. During his time in practice Will has worked across the RIBA Work Stages, from feasibility to project completion.

Will worked on the extension to Geneva Airport between 2013 and 2016, where he focused on the delivery of the cladding package, from scheme design through to tender submission. His role required careful coordination with all members of the design team in order to maintain the coherent and clearly articulated visual appearance of the building.

More recently, Will has been integral to the delivery of the Landmark House project in Hammersmith, London, which received planning permission in August 2017. Here he was involved with the process from feasibility, through to community consultation and on to planning submission.

He has subsequently been involved on a number of competitions, and the development of projects at early stages of the design process, both in the UK and overseas.

He became a member of the RSHP recruitment team in 2019 and is also a mentor to junior staff members.

Alongside his work in practice, Will has taught prospective, undergraduate and post-graduate students at The Bartlett School of Architecture, UCL where he has also been a visiting critic since 2010.

He is currently acting as practice tutor for the postgraduate Design Realisation module where he aims to synthesise the realities of practice with the aspirations of academia.
